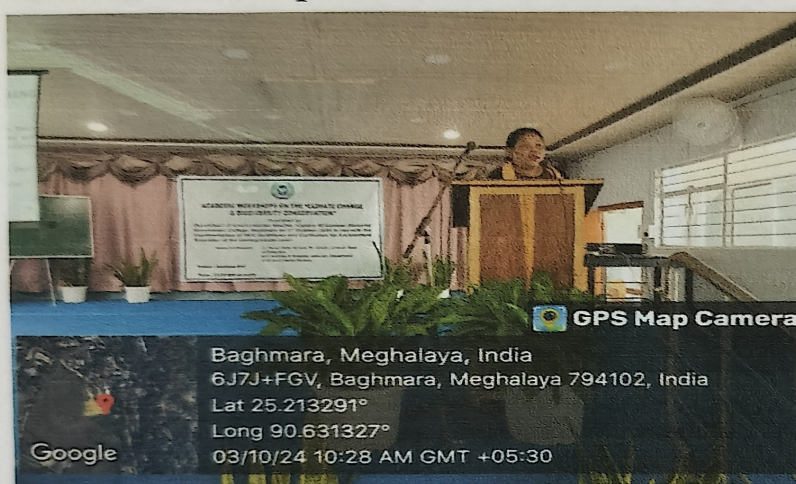

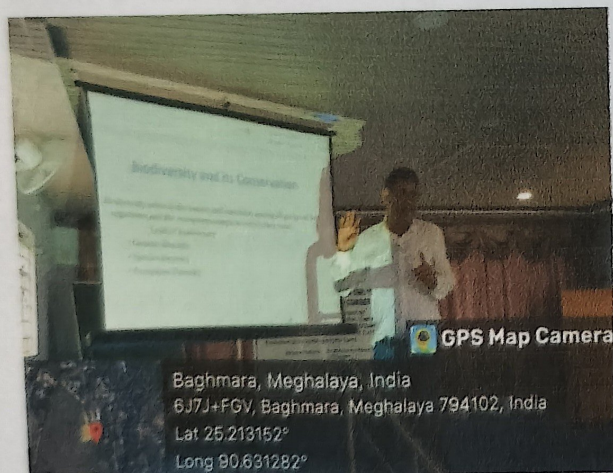
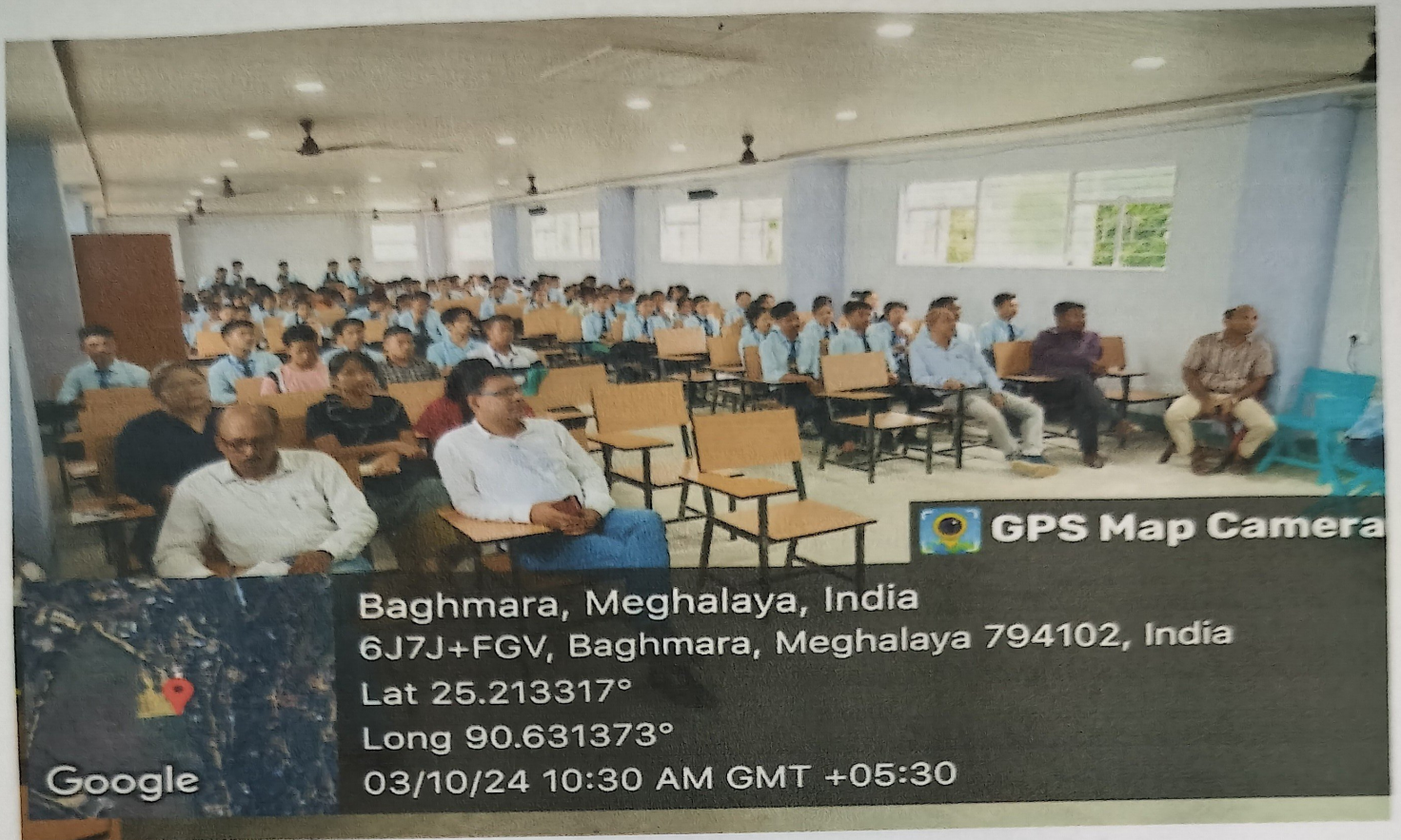
Date and Venue: The workshop took place on 3rd October, 2024 at Seminar Hall, Captain Williamson Memorial Govt. College, Baghmara.

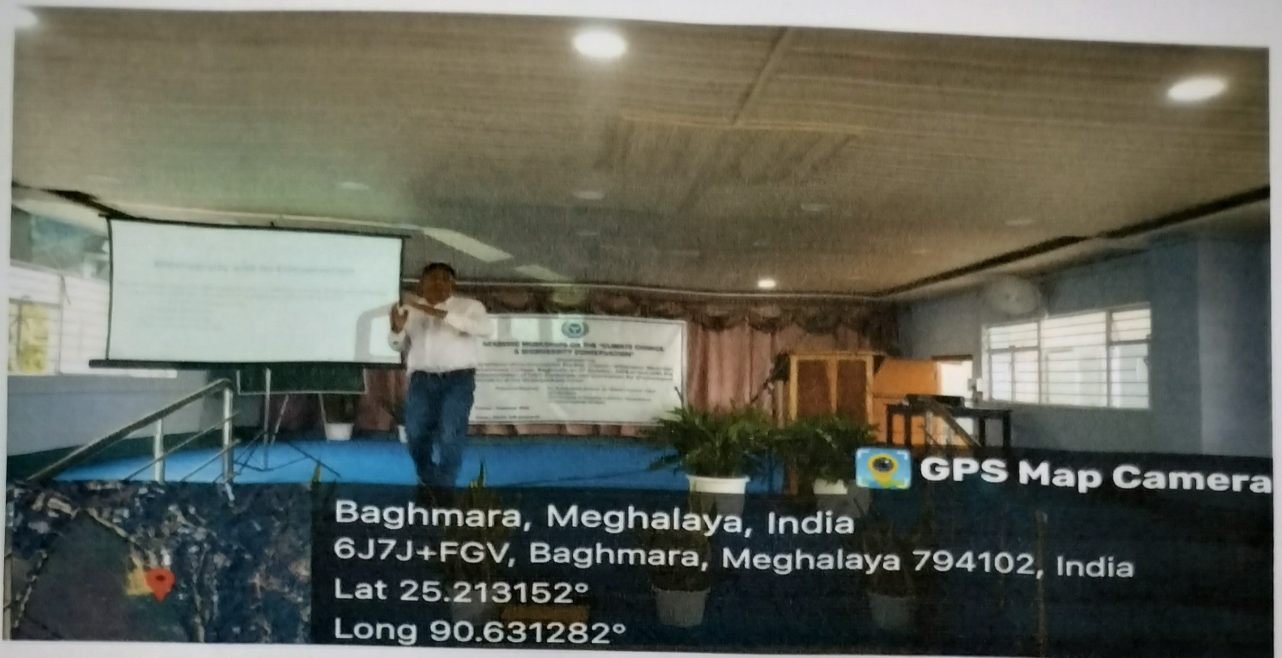

programme not only to the students but the common masses of the society.

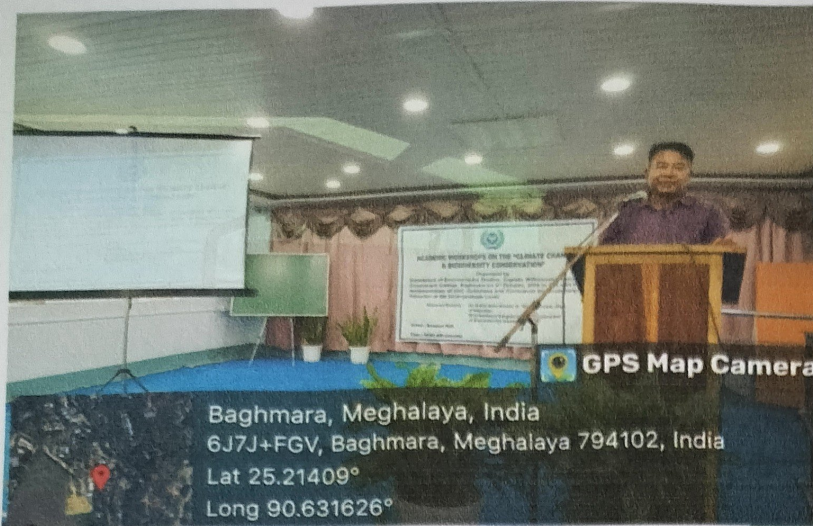
